SOL Forest School, the first all-outdoor, all-weather Forest School in the state of New Mexico, is looking for professionals to join our team. We are a growing program and our '23-'24 expansion plans include weekly sessions for children ages 3-10 years, an after school program for K-5th, Summer forest fun sessions & camps, as well as a few other potential offerings.

If you are passionate about connecting young children to nature, experiencing a well-established forest school first-hand, and have skills, interests, ideas & passions that could creatively contribute to our expanding program, then this could be for you!

Lead Forest School Guides are paid twice monthly throughout the forest school year & rate of pay is based on applicable experience & training. An end-of-year incentive will be awarded to FSGs who work the full school year with us. SOL will also partially fund ECE & FS trainings, as our budget allows.

- Minimum requirements to apply:
- 21 years or older
- college degree (Associate's or higher)
- two references & a cleared background check required
- 8 hrs. per week minimum for 16 weeks; this includes some time for session planning & team meetings (preference given to candidates willing & able to work 2-3 sessions/days a week)
- ability to work in an all-outdoor environment in ALL conditions & seasons
- ability to lift 50+lbs (weight of a young child) & a good level of health/fitness required
- Wilderness First Aid training a plus
- experience working with young children strongly desired
- experience working in nature a plus
- ability to self-reflect & work within a collaborative team is required
- ability to attend occasional trainings is required
- desire to collaboratively work in a creative, welcoming, growing program a plus
- Forest School certification from a recognized training program is required or, in rare instances, a candidate with a combination of early childhood training, outdoor/ environmental education training, work experience, Wilderness First Aid training, & skill in managing risk & supporting young children's risky & adventurous play, may be considered for the LEAD FOREST SCHOOL GUIDE position.
